CREATIVE WRITING - Poetry Stimulus - COMMENCING 16 May 2013

Use a poem as the basis for a short story.

Guidance

Your answer should be around 600 words in length and use as its inspiration a poem of your choice from the AQA Conflict Anthology.

The achievement objectives for this assessment state that it should:

- Write to communicate clearly, effectively and imaginatively, using and adapting forms and selecting vocabulary appropriate to task and purpose in ways that engage the reader.
- Organise information and ideas into structured and sequenced sentences, paragraphs and whole texts, using a variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence.
- Use a range of sentence structures for clarity, purpose and effect, with accurate punctuation and spelling.

Conditions:

This assessment will be run under controlled conditions - which means that no assistance can be rendered, and students only have access to the official resource materials for its entire duration.

- ► The assessment will be run over two episodes, during class periods.
- ▶ A single sheet of notes and a copy of your selected poem (un-annotated) may be brought to the assessment.
